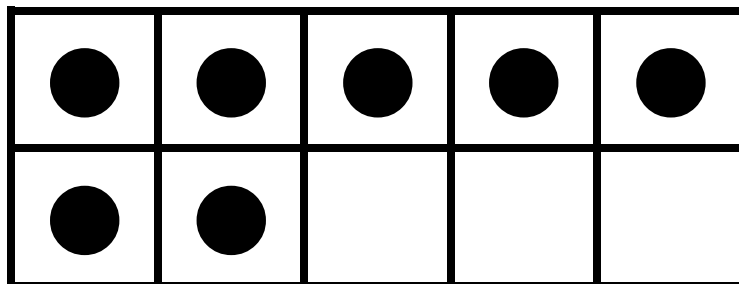


Base Ten Facts and Decomposition

A Short Daily Drill

1. Hold up a card **briefly**, about four seconds. Put it face down and **ask, "How many counters did you see?"**

Do **NOT give them time to slowly count! ☺**



2. Student answer: "7"

3. **Ask, "How do you know?"**

4. Student answer: *"I know there are 7, because I saw 5 + 2 more."*

5. **Say, "So $5 + 2 \text{ more} = 7$," and write $5 + 2 = 7$**

6. **Ask, "How many more would I need to make 10?"**

7. Student answer: "3"

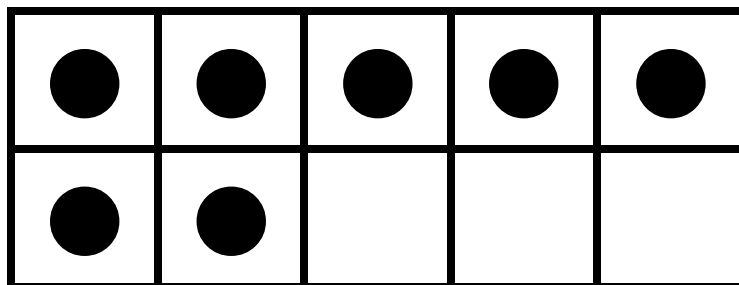
8. **Say, "So, $7 + 3 \text{ more} = 10$," and write $7 + 3 = 10$**

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
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

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
