The Board of Education heard Oral Communications from Members of the Board of Education, Superintendent, and Administrators.

1. Mrs. Samperi thanked the community for over \$40,000 in donations on tonight's agenda.
2. Mr. LaPlante reported that the Governor is not going to make any additional cuts to our budget this year. Currently California is 50th in the nation in spending on public education. He added that the State must get its priorities in order and education should be a priority.
3. Mr. LaPlante will be meeting with Assemblymember Lara this month to discuss the budget issues related to education and request his support in a pledge to not suspend Proposition 98.
4. Mr. Morris thanked Kevin Condon for the successful refinancing of \$12,105,000 in voter-approved general obligation bonds, which will amount to a gross debt service savings to taxpayers exceeding \$1.0 million.
5. Mr. Morris had the opportunity to attend the YMCA Senior Health Fair, which had a lot of great information and was a wonderful event.
6. Mr. Corrin thanked Mr. Morris on behalf of the YMCA.
7. Mr. Gutierrez had the pleasure of attending the Warren High Senior Awards program and commended the AVID students who received \$250,000.
8. Mr. Gutierrez congratulated the 12 student athletes who signed their letters of intent to play collegiate sports.

9. Ms. Swenson enjoyed attending the Warren High School play “The Dining Room” and thought it was very interesting.
10. Ms. Swenson also enjoyed attending the Downey High School musical “Little Shop of Horrors”. It was nice that Project Lead The Way students built the mechanical plant for the musical.
11. Ms. Swenson reported that she appreciates the Career Technical Education programs and was impressed reading the goals listed in the Application for Funding.
12. Mrs. Sodetani had the pleasure of attending the Warren High School play “Café Broadway” and thought it was great.
13. Mr. Corrin was able to attend the Warren High school play “The Dining Room” and the Warren High School Senior Awards.
14. Mr. Corrin congratulated the 350 students that were recognized at the academic awards.
15. Mr. Corrin noted that at the last Personnel Commission meeting there was great cooperation. He commended Ken Kato and the Personnel Commissioners for providing great service to the classified employees.
