2. Mrs. Samperi enjoyed attending the Downey High School sealbearers banquet, Sussman Middle School promotion, and Warren High School graduation.
3. Mrs. Samperi thanked Mrs. King-Brown for the transition information provided to all principals that will be changing schools.
4. Mrs. Samperi thanked Mary Jo Enyeart for all the work she has done with the CHARACTER COUNTS! program throughout the District. She has really made a difference.
