The Board of Education heard a presentation from Tom Houts, Principal of Downey High School, honoring Evelyn Cruz in Gratitude for Selfless Action in a Crisis.

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS HEARD
The Board of Education heard Oral Communications from Members of the Board of Education, Superintendent, and Administrators.

1. Mr. Gutierrez reported that student enrollment has increased, which is good news.
2. Mr. Gutierrez expressed his appreciation for the information he received on AYP and API scores. He noted that we are heading in the right direction and commended teachers and administrators for their hard work in this area.
3. Mr. Gutierrez shared that a recent article he read stated that other school districts are cutting sports due to the budget. He noted that it is fortunate we haven't had to make those types of cuts.
4. Mr. Gutierrez expressed his condolences to Mr. LaPlante on the passing of his mother.
5. Mr. Corrin was encouraged to see that our enrollment numbers are more than projected.
6. Mr. Corrin reported that the absentee analysis of employees was encouraging and noted that the number of substitute days was down significantly last year.
7. Mrs. Sodetani added that the reduction in absences is most likely connected to the Wellness Program and Dr. Doty's visit to each school.
8. Mrs. Sodetani extended her sympathy to Mr. LaPlante.
9. Mrs. Sodetani announced that on Saturday the City of Downey will be offering free flu shots to residents.
10. Mrs. Sodetani thanked Mrs. Sims for the Financial Report and appreciates the work required in preparing the report.

11. Mrs. Sodemani enjoyed attending several Back-to-School nights. We are already on track, running smoothly, and looking good.
12. Mr. LaPlante thanked Board Members and District staff for their condolences.
13. Ms. Swenson congratulated Warren High School for receiving the Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Sports Grand Prize Award. They are the only high school in the State of California to receive this award. The Grand Prize award includes a fitness center with a retail value of \$100,000.
14. Ms. Swenson shared information about a "Reading by Nine" portion of the *Los Angeles Times* provided in Sunday's paper. It includes ideas for students and parents.
15. Mrs. Samperi thanked the Downey Kiwanis Foundation for the donation of \$30,000 to be used in support of "Project Lead the Way" at Warren High School.
16. Mrs. Samperi reported that the Los Angeles Unified School District is so overcrowded, students must sit on the floor.
17. Mrs. Samperi wished the student athletes well in the upcoming season.
18. Dr. Doty reported that we were able to hire back 23 of our temporary teachers and thanked everyone for the work done and the team effort.
19. Dr. Doty added that East Whittier City School District is cutting five days of school, noting that times are tough.
20. Mrs. Samperi announced that on October 20, 2009 at 3:30 p.m. we will be dedicating the *D. Mark Morris Hall* building at Downey High School.
