GUIDE TO IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIRED FOR SCHOOL ENTRY
2018 -2019
Grades K – 12

To enter or transfer into public and private elementary and secondary schools (grades K -12), children under age 19 must have immunizations as outlined below.

ACCORDING TO LAW SB277 PERSONAL BELIEFS EXEMPTIONS ARE NOT ACCEPTED!
NO SHOTS - NO RECORDS - NO SCHOOL!

VACCINE

POLIO (OPV OR IPV)

Kindergarten to 1st grade (4-6 Years) - 4 Doses

(3 doses sufficient if one was given on or after 4th birthday)

In addition, if 4 doses are administered before age 4, an additional 5th dose is required at age 4 through 6 years

Grades: 2 – 12 (7-18 years) - 4 doses (3 doses sufficient if last dose was given on or after 2nd birthday)

DIPHTHERIA, TETANUS, and PERTUSSIS

Grades: Kindergarten to 1st (4-6 Years) - 5 doses

(4 doses sufficient if last dose given on or after 4th birthday)

Grades: 2-6 (7-11 Years) - 4 DTaP doses

(3 doses sufficient if one was given on or after 2nd birthday)

Grades: 7-12 (11-18 Years) - 4 DTaP doses **plus**

1 TDaP Booster (TDaP Adacel or Boostrix, DTaP or DTP); Must have been given after age 7

Students with no history of having had the DTaP/DTP series must receive the following:

- 1 TDaP
- 1 Td (4 weeks after TDaP)
- 1 Td (6 months after the Td)

MEASLES, MUMPS, and RUBELLA (MMR) - 2 doses *Both doses must be on or after the first birthday.*

HEPATITIS B - 3 doses required

VARICELLA (Chickenpox) - 1 dose required (2 doses required if 1st dose was given on or after 13th birthday)

TB SCREENING/TB SKIN TEST

TB Skin Test Requirements if indicated by provider:

Students coming from outside of the USA for the first time must have record of a TB skin test or screening by a medical provider.

- All preschool students advancing to TK/Kindergarten must have a TB skin test or screening within one year before beginning Kindergarten. Skin test/screening must be done after August 15, 2017.

- Students who have traveled to a high-incidence country, (e.g., Asia, Middle East, Africa, Latin America, and countries of the former Soviet Union) for an extended period, **at least one week**, must provide a new TB/Screening before re-enrolling.

Verification must include:

- Date of screening or date of TB skin test if given (both given and reading/result dates are required).
- Students with previous **positive** TB skin test must provide:
 - Report of a chest X-ray, with a written statement (can be on the immunization record card) from a physician or health department stating the child is free of communicable tuberculosis.
- **A child with a positive skin test can be admitted to school conditionally for up to 20 school days while awaiting chest x-ray clearance.**

Conditional Admissions

Children who lack one or more required vaccine doses that are not currently due may be admitted on condition that they receive the remaining doses when due, according to the requirements on reverse.
